

CONTRACT & AGREEMENT

FINGER LAKES KENNEL CLUB (FLKC)
AND
ITHACA DOG TRAINING CLUB (IDTC)

Purpose: Establishing procedures for the operation of Obedience Trials at the Spring and Fall all-breed point shows, sponsored by the Finger Lakes Kennel Club.

IT IS AGREED THAT:

1. The Ithaca Dog Training Club (hereafter referred to as IDTC) will present a name or names for Obedience Chairperson to the president of the Finger Lakes Kennel Club (hereafter referred to as FLKC) 12 months in advance of the show, for approval by the FLKC show chairman. The Obedience Chairperson(s) does not have to be a member of the FLKC.
2. The Obedience Chairperson may not show or own dogs shown in either the conformation or obedience competition at the show they chair.
3. IDTC will provide the trophies for obedience and will take full responsibility for the operation of the obedience trophy table, including staffing.
4. The FLKC Show Chairman will outline in writing to the Obedience Chairperson 9 months in advance of the show, the time table for trophy lists, catalog ads, and any other business critical to putting the show and trial together.
5. The IDTC will provide the stewards necessary to staff the obedience rings for the day.
6. The IDTC ~~Chairperson~~ will present, 18 months before the show (sooner if possible), a list of potential obedience judges to the FLKC Chairperson. From this list, if possible, the FLKC will hire the obedience judges, working with the other clubs in the respective cluster.
7. IDTC will provide one person to assist in judges transportation, primarily at lunch time.
8. FLKC will assume financial responsibility for the obedience judge fees and transportation. The FLKC will also take full responsibility for communicating with the judges, arranging the hospitality, provide tenting, rings and clean up. The FLKC will also provide lunch for judges, obedience chairperson, workers, stewards and ~~X~~ trophy persons who work a minimum of 4 hours at the show.

If either the FLKC or IDTC fails to fulfil any part of this agreement than this agreement can be nullified, or revised at the request of the other club.
