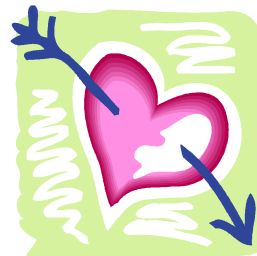

# General Meeting Minutes

IDTC General meeting Minutes  
January 24, 2012

The meeting was held at Baker Lab, following a dish-to-pass dinner with some very tasty food.

Treasurer Bruce Coleman reported that there had been little financial activity in the last month, but that balances in the Club accounts were slightly higher than for the previous year.

Training Director Kerry Boisvert reported that the current Beginner and Puppy classes are going well, but that most of the advanced classes had been canceled due to lack of people signing up. She pointed out that much of the Club's income comes from the Beginner classes and made a plea for more volunteers to instruct these classes. The Pavilion is only available sporadically for the spring; there will be a mini follow-up session (for people currently in Beginner or Puppy class) in March-May, and possibly some short specialty sessions. The next full-length session will start in June.

President Marian Szebenyi reported that the Board had discussed Open Training on Tuesdays and recommended that we have free open training from 6-8 P.M. on Tuesdays. There is a class in the building from 7-8, but instructor Jan Estes is happy to have people use half the floor space for open training. Anybody who already paid for Open Training this session can request a refund from the Treasurer.

## OLD Business:

The December 10 show-and-go and the Christmas Party were successes. The new "in Memoriam" page at the party (and in the Newsletter) was well received.

The purchase of new agility equipment, to replace worn-out items and to make all equipment compliant with CPE specifications, was approved by the Board.

Donna Webster will be in charge of the show-and-go to be held March 4 in the Cornell Equestrian Center in conjunction with the FLKC match. There will be Obedience and Rally, and Donna will need judges, stewards, registration table workers, and help transporting equipment from the Pavilion. Bruce Coleman reported on developments on a future Obedience seminar. Some of the people he was considering are either unavailable or will be giving another seminar nearby, so options are limited. The Good Sportsmanship Award was presented by Ray Corey to Tammy and Joe Osmeloski.

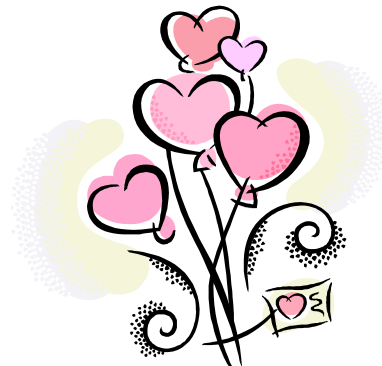
Marian is working on a program for February, but suggestions for future meetings are welcome – contact the President if you have an idea.
