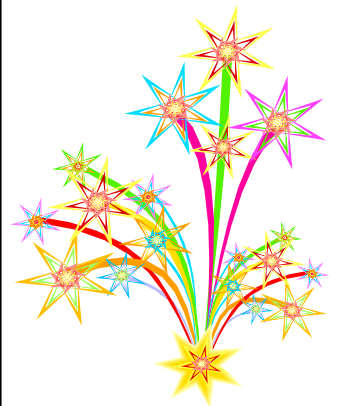

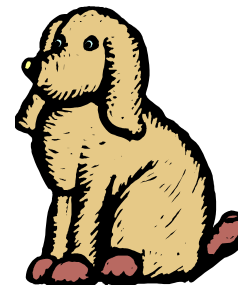

General Meeting Minutes

IDTC General meeting Minutes
JUNE 2011

After an excellent presentation on Search and Rescue by Juli Lathrop and Cheryl Runyan of the Kramer Foundation, the meeting was called to order at about 8:30 P.M. by President Marian Szebenyi.

The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted with two corrections:

It was Donna Webster, not Sue Yanoff, who was to contact Myers Park about the July and August picnics (she has now done so).
"ASPCA" should have been "SPCA".

The Secretary and Treasurer being absent, there were no reports from them. The President reported for the Board that the Club did well financially in June, making about \$5000, of which about \$2000 came from the CPE Agility Trial. The Board had discussed the Trial and made a policy concerning the selection of Trial Committees for future trials. Those people interested in being on the Trial Committee for a possible trial next year should let Marian know. The Board approved a donation of \$500 to the Tompkins County Sheriff's Department for a new police dog; the donation had been pledged during the Cayuga Radio Group's fundraiser, so that the Club could be credited on-air with the donation.

Kerry Boisvert reported for the Training Committee that the Fall classes are scheduled to start just after Labor Day, and that recruitment of instructors for them is going well. Plans for Graduation for the current classes are also well in hand.

Old Business:

IDTC's first CPE Agility Trial went off successfully; a full report will be given next month.

Plans for the Temperament Test scheduled for August 14 are proceeding. Marian is working on getting two testers to serve in addition to Chief Tester Tom Szebenyi. Volunteer workers are needed; a sheet was passed for sign-ups, but more people are still needed – contact Marian if interested.

Volunteers are also needed to steward at the Point Show Thursday, Sept. 29. Some have signed up – thank you! - but we will probably need more. Again, contact Marian if interested.

Julia Bentley will be the new webmistress. The new system will allow multiple people to update the site, which should make it easier to keep the pages up to date. Many thanks to Lisa Mitchell, who has maintained the web site for the last several

years!

Tammy Snyder was not present, but provided written information on possible sites, expenses, and charges for the Anne Paul obedience seminar scheduled for October 7-9. Members expressed concern about what would happen if not enough people signed up to cover expenses. Marian will contact Tammy about details of Anne Paul's contract, and about cancellation policies of the potential sites.

Sue Yanoff reported that the SPCA is interested in working with IDTC to put on a Responsible Dog Ownership Day event. The probable date is the weekend before the Wine Country shows. Sue had lots of ideas about things to do at the event. The membership authorized her to pursue planning for RDO Day and to talk further with the SPCA regarding a definite date and allocation of tasks such as advertising.

The next meeting will be a dish-to-pass picnic at Myers Park in Lansing, 6:30 P.M. on July 26. There will also be an equipment swap/sale and Kerry Boisvert will present a short program on weight pulling.

New Member:

The Club approved the membership application of Rhonda Clouse, who has a Golden Retriever named Kona.

New Business:

The membership approved a donation of \$200 to the Kramer Foundation, the non-profit dog rescue and training group represented by the presenters of the evening's program.

The Cortland County SPCA is holding a "Fuzz Fest" on Saturday, August 13, and has invited IDTC to participate. Kerry Boisvert suggested that the Club have a table at the Fest, for which there is a fee of \$35 (or perhaps more if not reserved before July 1). She also proposed that we run a CGC test, provided that the Cortland SPCA will handle publicity for the test. The charge to take the test would be \$10, which would go to the SPCA. The membership approved of the idea, and Debbie Keith and Suzanne Etherington will contact the Cortland SPCA about it.

Meeting adjourned about 9:30 P.M.
