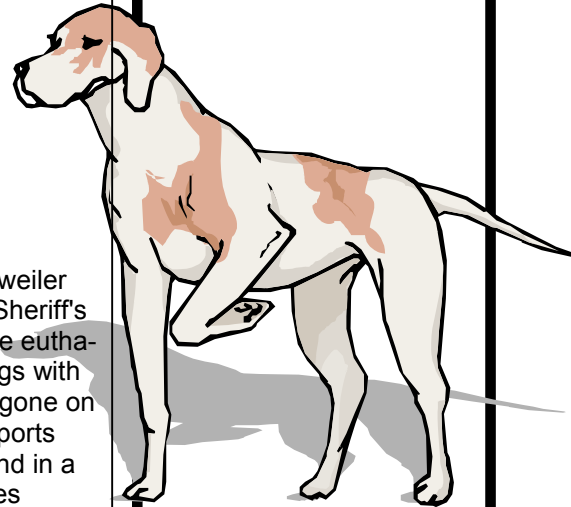
Search & Rescue

Juli Lanthrop founded the Kramer Foundation which was named after a Rottweiler that worked in the schools along side Juli in her job as a Chemung County Sheriff's Deputy. Kramer helps dogs in need, pulling them from shelters that would be euthanized due to unwanted behaviors but that also have potential to be good dogs with training. Many of the dogs that have gone through the Kramer Foundation have gone on to be working dogs in search & rescue, law enforcement, competition dog sports and especially in pairing dogs with at risk youth in school programs which end in a positive result for both dogs and youth. The Kramer Foundation also provides search dogs services to any requesting agency. The search dogs are certified through the International Police Work Dog Association in trailing, wilderness air scent and human remains detection. Juli and Cheryl are also members of the Tompkins County Search and Rescue Team, a non-pro-fit, all volunteer organization to assist DEC in searches for lost persons.

I have had the pleasure to track with these ladies & have learned alot!

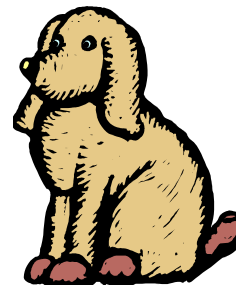

The meeting opened with a talk by Veterinary Technician Sharon Garland on First Aid for Dogs. Sharon emphasized the use of easily purchased household items to provide needed first aid. Her wide experience both personally and at work provided an insightful, handy and often amusing (or astonishing) list of things to do and medications to use – and NOT to do - or use - in an emergency situation.

Sharon emphasized these measures are – before you take your dog to the veterinarian, or when no vet is available. A handout gave a possible list of handy items for a first aid kit, and what to look for in various situations. Thank you, Sharon!

Meeting minutes from April meeting were approved as read.

Treasurer's Report:

We gained 4 new members, our income from membership is less this year.

Training Committee:
