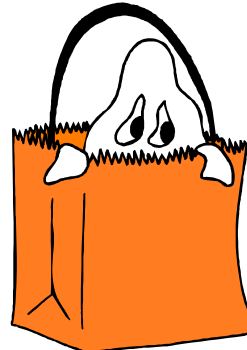

General Meeting Minutes

IDTC General meeting Minutes
September 2011

The general meeting was held in the Pavilion, with several new members in attendance. The Training Committee had set up obedience equipment to allow members to train before the meeting beginning at 6 pm as part of their Member Appreciation night.

Treasurer Bruce Coleman announced that the club had received \$2875 in registration fees, and the pavilion bill of \$1200. had been paid to Cornell for September.

Kerry Boisvert of the training committee announced that John Martindale has been approved as a pre-assistant instructor, and that Lisa Mitchell will be doing a training session for six pre-assistant instructors, and any current instructors who are interested on November 16th at the pavilion.

Kerry also mentioned the upcoming mini-sessions in November and December – more information will be available soon.

OLD Business:

The preliminary budget for next September's CPE Trial was approved.

The Christmas Party will again be held at the Ramada off Triphammer Road on December 11th.

The brunch will be from 11 am to 2 pm, and the price will be \$9.95, with no increase over last year. Forms will be available in the next newsletter, and the completed form and money will be due two weeks before the brunch.

We need a volunteer coordinator for the Christmas brunch raffle, as Tammy Snyder is unable to do it again. Party organizers Jen, Pat, and Diane agreed that they could manage the raffle.

IDTC members will be working with the Hubbard's Hounds Rescue Group in Homer to help them train their foster dogs in some basic obedience. Susan Beals and Brenda Finnicum will be organizing the Saturday, October 22, session.

A Show-and-Go was discussed, and a date of December

10 was agreed on. There will be agility in the morning, organized by Hannah Robinson, and obedience/rally in the afternoon, organized by Kathy Hildreth.

NEW Business:

The club is looking for someone to chair the Spring Point Show in Syracuse and organize volunteers. Lisa Mitchell volunteered, with Rue Chagoll helping.

A possible obedience seminar with Betsy Scapicchio of Top Dog Training in New Jersey is in the works. Bruce Coleman, Pat Welch and Jen Patterson have offered to co-organize it. Anyone interested in helping is asked to contact Marian

The Club has been asked to participate in the Pet Expo at the Ithaca Mall on October 22nd. We would only have an 8 x 8 space, a table, and two chairs. Anyone wishing to get involved should contact Marian, as there will not be room for many people or dogs. There is a Halloween Costume competition as well.

Two new family members: Michelle Kelly and Bill Buxton; and the Jacobs family were voted in, and a reinstatement of membership for Lori Tyler.

For the November meeting, a suggestion was made to have Abbie Tamber do a program on Nosework. Marian will check with Abbie about this.

The discussion of getting not-for-profit status for IDTC will resume at the October meeting.

The formal meeting ended at 8:30 to allow Training Committee Chair Kerry Boisvert to talk about the numerous club activities in the past year, and give out raffle prizes for new and old members.
