IDTC General meeting Minutes
AUGUST 2011

The meeting opened at 7:30 at the lakefront pavilion in Myers Park after a dish-to-pass picnic.

There was no board meeting, and the general meeting was run by Vice President Pat Welch, in the absence of President Marian Szebenyi.

There was no treasurer's report at the meeting, the treasurer being absent.

Training Committee Chair Kerry Boisvert reported that Fall classes are still filling. There may be a need for an additional Beginners class instructor if those classes continue to register. Today is the last day listed for registration, but Kerry will extend final registration several days.

Kerry asked if there was anyone who would be interested in helping a group in Homer with dog training. Their idea was that each of the members would bring a dog. Kerry was unsure of how many dogs this would involve, or what level of help the handlers need. Suggestions were made to have a night at the pavilion to do this – a club volunteer to head this project would be needed.

Kathy Hildreth reported on the issues with the date for next year's CPE Trial. Our mid-June date has been pre-empted due to the recent announcement by CPE Officials that their Nationals will be held at both sides of the country, and the eastern National is being held in Altamont (near Albany) New York.

Given the number of CPE events in our area, the only available date with no conflicts would be Labor Day (Sept. 1-2), 2012. By having a 2 day - rather than 3 day show, it would leave competitors time to go home and enjoy

Labor Day Monday with their families. Kathy had tentatively asked a judge who would be willing to judge for us that weekend. The site at Robert Treman is available for that date, also.
